Awards Criteria

Superior Cadet (Annual): Awarded to the top overall cadet in each LET level

- N-1-1 **Distinguished Cadet** (Annual): Awarded to the top overall cadet in the battalion. Scholar, Athlete Leader (SAL)
- N-1-2 Academic Excellence (Annual): Awarded to the cadet with the highest (weighted) cumulative GPA in each LET level
- N-1-3 Academic Achievement (Semester): Awarded to cadets who earn and "A" in JROTC and a "B" or better in all other courses.
- N-1-4 Attendance (Annual): Awarded to cadets who have 0 unexcused absences and no more than 3 excused absences for the year in all classes.
- N-1-5 **Student Government** (Annual): Awarded to cadets who serve as officers in the student government, the ASB or other official school clubs. Awarded to cadets who serve as Peer mediators and/or Link Crew
- N-1-6 **LET Service** (Annual): Awarded to cadets who complete both semesters for each LET level (One award per LET Level)
- N-1-7 **Scholastic Excellence** (Semester): Awarded to cadets who achieve a 3.75 or higher (non-weighted) GPA during a semester.
- N-1-8 **Fundraising** (Annual): Awarded for meeting individual fundraising benchmarks. Criteria established by Instructors.
- N-1-9 Honor Company (Annual): Awarded to all cadets in the Honor Company
- N-1-10 Academic Teams (Per event): Awarded to cadets who participate on winning teams during academically related competitions (Academic Decathlon, First Aid Triage).
- N-3-1 **DAI/SAI Instructor Leadership** (Annual): Awarded to cadets who demonstrate high level of leadership and leadership potential as determined by the SAI.

- N-3-2 **Personal Appearance** (Per event): Awarded to cadets (one LET I and one LET II per company) who are selected to compete in the Cadet of the Month Competition.
- N-3-3 Proficiency (Annual): Awarded to cadets in the top 25% (JROTC Grade) of each LET level
- N-3-4 **Drill Team** (Annual): Awarded to cadets who participate in at least one competition during the year (Armed/Unarmed/4-Person).
- N-3-5 Orienteering: Currently not in use at MMHS
- N-3-6 **Color Guard / Honor Guard** (Annual): Awarded to cadets who participate as members of Color Guard or Honor Guard.
- N-3-8 **Adventure Training** (Per event) Awarded to cadets who complete every event during JCLC. Awarded to cadets who participate in other adventure training, as determined by Instructors.
- N-3-9 **Commendation** (Per event): Awarded to cadets whose performance of duty exceeds that expected of a cadet at the current level. (Examples include- Guidon Bearer, Flag Detail, Eco Club Champion, Canned Food Drive Winner et al.)
- N-3-10 Good Conduct (Annual): Awarded to cadets who earn "O" in conduct in every course during the academic year
- N-3-11 JCLC (Annual): Awarded to cadets who participate in JCLC
- N-3-12 **Cadet Chronicle** (Annual): Awarded to cadets who write a JROTC related article for publication in the JROTC Times. Article does not need to be published in order to receive this award.
- N-3-13 Best Squad Drill (Annual): Awarded to members of the winning squad during squad drill competition
- N-3-14 **Best Platoon Drill** (Annual): Awarded to members of the winning squad during platoon drill competition
- N-3-15 **Best Company Drill** (Annual): Awarded to members of the winning squad during company drill competition.

Cadet Challenge Ribbon (Cadet Challenge): Awarded to the top 5 boys and girls (overall Cadet Challenge score) in each company.

- N-2-1 Varsity Athletics (Annual): Awarded to cadets who complete a full season on at least one varsity athletic team (Cheerleading included).
- N-2-2 **Physical Fitness** (Cadet Challenge): Awarded to cadets who score in the 85 percentile or higher in every event of the Cadet Challenge.

- N-2-3 **JROTC Athletics** (Cadet Challenge): Awarded to cadets who score in the 50 percentile or higher in every event of the Cadet Challenge.
- N-2-4 **Most Fit** (Cadet Challenge): Awarded to the top boy and girl in each of the following categories-Shuttle Run, Push Up, Curl Up, Pull Up, 1-Mile Run
- N-2-5 **JROTC Athletic Teams** (Per event): Awarded to members of winning JROTC athletic teams (*Volleyball, Basketball, Amazing Race et al.*)
- N-4-1 **Parade** (One Time Award): Awarded to cadets who participate in a Parade or Battalion Review Ceremony (Veterans Day or Memorial Day).
- N-4-2 **Recruiting** (Annual): Awarded to cadets who recruit (2) or more cadets into the program. New cadets must stay in the program past the first uniform day in order to provide full recruiting credit.
- N-4-3 Meritorious Service Points (One Time Award): Awarded to cadets who achieve 30 MSP's
- N-4-4 Military Ball (Per Event): Awarded for attendance to the MMHS Military Ball
- N-4-5 **Summer Leadership Program** (Annual): Awarded to cadets who participate in 80% or more of the Matador Summer Leadership Program.
- N-4-6 **Service Learning** (Annual): Awarded to cadets who participate in the annual service learning project.
- N-4-7 **Excellent Staff Performance** (Annual at end of 1st Semester): Awarded to staff officers for excellent performance
